Friendly Reminders:

* Please check your child's backpack every day for assignments and notes. These will be found in your child's individual folder and notebook.

*It is important that the content in class is reinforced at home; therefore, I encourage you to read to your child every day and have them assist with turning the pages. I also recommend that you count with them, review basic shapes and colors and allow them to explore their five senses by introducing them to new objects, sounds, smells and tastes.

* I also encourage you to help your child to become more independent by allowing them to take a more active role in their daily living. I recommend that you have them assist in zipping/unzipping, brushing their teeth, eating, washing and putting their clothes, shoes and backpacks away.

In October, we will continue to work on daily living skills, following rules, sharing and independent goals.

- **Language Arts:** We will be starting the day with our morning circle activities which include the calendar, weather, feelings and story time. During story time, each student will have the opportunity to identify pictures and words, and will continue to assist in turning the pages of the book. In October we will be working on letters B-D.
- **Mathematics:** We will continue to focus on numbers 1-5. Additionally, Students will participate in a variety of activities that are designed to help them understand that numbers have value and purpose. Please continue to review numbers and their representations with your child at home.
- **Science:** In science we will continue exploring objects by sight, touch, sound, taste and smell. We will begin using our sensory table by participating in a variety of activities designed to stimulate the senses.
- **Social Studies:** We will continue practicing good citizenship by following rules, sharing/passing and being safe at all times.
