Lice Prevention Tips

Here are some tips to help prevent your child from getting lice.

- Tie hair up in ponytails or braids
- Do not share hats, combs or other items that touch the head
- Do routine head checks at home. Comb out any eggs found in the scalp
- Preventative Spray: Mix Mint Listerine and Water. Spray on shared items (hats, headphones, etc). Can also buy Spray at Target
- Inform the teacher if your child has lice
